Eriko Wadsworth, owner and designer of Annalisa Style Floral Design Studio, “loves incorporating vines into a bouquet, as they bring out the lushness of the garden rose, while adding a touch of whimsical playfulness,” she says. “These bouquets represent a fairy-tale rose garden – whimsical and romantic.”

The bridal bouquet is a romantic mix of Yves Piaget garden roses, Marina roses, ranunculus, anemone, freesia and smilax vine. The stems are hand-tied in coordinating pink ribbons.

The bridesmaid bouquet is a perfect complement, with a mixture of Marina roses, ranunculus and freesia. The stems are also hand-tied in a coordinating pink ribbon.

A matching boutonniere of Yves Piaget garden rose, freesia and smilax vine finishes out this beautiful trio. >
